Known as the Capital of Albariño Wine, the city of Cambados has always been linked to this precious wine, since it was here where the Rías Baixas Denomination of Origin was born. This is reflected in its streets, where the wine culture is always present.

The Albariño Wine Festival, declared of National Tourist Interest, is one of the oldest and most important oenogastronomic festivals in Spain. During the days of its celebration the city receives about 300,000 people. Our wines are elaborated with loving care, in the traditional way, with our own hands, from pruning to harvesting. In fact, harvesting is one of the most endearing moments, where each day ends enjoying albariño and our excellent gastronomy with friends and relatives.


